### APPROVAL CRITERIA

Requests for Glyxambi (empagliflozin/linagliptin) may be approved when the following criteria are met:

- I. Individual has had a trial and inadequate response or intolerance to metformin; **OR**
- II. Individual has a contraindication to metformin therapy [such as but not limited to, renal insufficiency ( eGFR is less than 45 mL/minute/1.73 m<sup>2</sup>)];  
**AND**
- III. Individual has had a trial and inadequate response or intolerance to one DPP-4 inhibitor (for example but not limited to, Janumet, Janumet XR, Januvia, Jentadueto, Juvisync, Tradjenta) **OR** one SGLT2 inhibitor (for example but not limited to, Invokana, Jardiance, Farxiga, Xigduo XR).

Glyxambi (empagliflozin/linagliptin) may **not** be approved for any of the following:

- I. Individual is requesting Glyxambi (empagliflozin/linagliptin) with an eGFR less than 45 mL/min/1.73 m<sup>2</sup>; **OR**
- II. Individual is requesting for treatment of type 1 diabetes mellitus.
