APPROVAL CRITERIA

Requests for increased quantities will be granted for the following diagnosis and quantities:

- I. Chronic Bacterial Prostatitis:
 - a. Up to 28 tablets per fill; **OR**
 - b. Up to 840 ml per fill;

OR

- II. Inhalation Anthrax:
 - a. Up to 1 tablet per day for length requested per benefit allowance; **OR**
 - b. Up to 30 mL per day, allowable for length requested per benefit allowance;

OR

- III. Complicated diabetic foot Ulcer:
 - a. Up to 1 tablet per day for length requested per benefit allowance; **OR**
 - b. Up to 30 mL per day, allowable for length requested per benefit allowance;

OR

- IV. Chronic Pseudomonas infection in individuals with Cystic Fibrosis:
 - a. Up to 1 tablet per day for length requested per benefit allowance; **OR**
 - b. Up to 30 mL per day, allowable for length requested per benefit allowance;

OR

- V. Plague or inhalational anthrax in pediatric individuals receiving Levaquin (levofloxacin) 250 mg tablets or the oral solution:

This policy does not apply to health plans or member categories that do not have pharmacy benefits, nor does it apply to Medicare. Note that market specific restrictions or transition-of-care benefit limitations may apply.
