POLICY:

Anthem Inc. requires that all subcontracts meet requirements established by Federal and state laws, regulations, and guidelines with respect to the delegation of utilization management/review functions.

DEFINITIONS:

PROCEDURE:

Medicaid Compliance will ensure that any subcontract for the delegation of utilization management/review functions include a provision in the subcontract agreement requiring that only licensed physicians who are of the same or similar specialty and subspecialty should make an utilization management/review decision, when possible.

Medicaid Compliance will ensure the review for this provision occurs during the following:

- Initiation of any new subcontract for the delegation of utilization management/review functions
- Initiation of any amendment to an existing subcontract for the delegation of utilization management/review functions
- Annual review of any existing subcontract for the delegation of utilization management/review functions
