

Coronavirus relief funds

At the request of DMAS, HealthKeepers, Inc. is sending this communication to all of its providers.

Anthem HealthKeepers Plus providers now have the opportunity to receive coronavirus relief funds to support them during the COVID-19 health emergency. The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) is allocating \$15 billion to providers who participate in Medicaid and the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) and have not received a payment from the Provider Relief Fund General Allocation.

The deadline to submit applications is July 20, 2020. DMAS encourages providers to apply even if you are uncertain whether you are eligible.

The payment amount will be at least 2% of reported gross revenue from Medicaid and CHIP care. Providers are required to provide data to HHS, including the number of Medicaid patients served. Visit the [DMAS website](#) for more information.
